And like last year, there will be one single Yom Kippur morning service which begins at 10am on Saturday, September 30th. Since these are all on a first-come, first-served basis, we urge you to register now by completing and returning the registration form in this packet, or by registering online at hh.trt.org.

Please be sure to include your loved ones in our *Yiskor* Memorial Book which will be distributed during each *Yiskor* service in the coming year. I also encourage you to add your name to our Rosh Hashanah Greeting Card which is mailed to our entire congregation in September.
